4. Make a bee from playdough
5. Collect 1 yellow and 1 black item
Put the 2 items in a zip bag

6. Egg Carton Bumble Bee
Make a bumble bee from part of an egg carton

Extra Special:

7. Make a bumble bee from a paper cup

Ages 4 & 5:

8. Make a bumble bee using popsicle sticks
9. Collect 5 yellow and 5 black items
Put 5 yellow and 5 black things in a PLASTIC jar and write BEE on the lid
10. Make a bumble bee from a paper lunch bag

11. Make a bee from play dough or clay
Display on a paper plate
12. Draw a beehive with bees
On a paper 8 ½ x 11"

Special:

13. Make a beehive using egg cartons
No larger than 8" x 8"

Extra Special:

14. Flower Garden
Make a flower garden on a paper plate using any cereal

Ages 6 to 8:

15. Bookmark
Create a bookmark using any material, decorate with bee theme
16. Collage
Collage of both flowers and bees on paper 8 ½" x 11" (completely covered with no writing or title)
17. Birthday card
Make a card for your Honey Bee friend on their 7th birthday
18. Pet Bee
If you had a pet bee, what would you name it?
Write its' name and 2 sentences about what makes your bee special.

Build a lego garden or flowers that bees would like (no larger than 10" x 10" (including base)
