# Junior Prize List

- Parents are urged to allow their children to do the work and preparation for their exhibits without assistance. Please read and help your children understand the rules, encourage them and help them to get their exhibits to the fair.
- No more than one entry by an exhibitor in each numbered item.
- Grades are based on the grade you are in while attending school in June 2026, not the grade you are going into in September 2026.

**Preschool/JK/SK:**

- 1. Make a farm animal puppet using a paper lunch bag**  
Use imagination to decorate.
- 2. Create a lamb using a paper plate and cotton balls**  
Add features to the lamb
- 3. Penmanship. Print the letter 'F' and the word 'Farm'**  
On an 8½" X 11" page and decorate the page
- 4. Make a farm animal from playdough**  
Display on a paper plate
- 5. Paint a rock as a farm animal**  
Name the rock. Rock to be no larger than 6" in any direction

**Special**

- 6. Egg carton chicks**  
Create no more than 6 chicks using egg carton cups. Paint and decorate.

**Grade 1 & 2:**

- 7. Draw a barn yard scene**  
Must be on an 8½" X 11" paper
- 8. Create a popsicle stick photo frame**  
Decorate with the farm theme
- 9. Plastic pop bottle, farm animal coin bank**  
Decorate a pop bottle to look like a farm animal
- 10. Hand print farm animal**  
Decorate and make your hand print into a farm animal on an 8½" X 11" piece of paper
- 11. Marshmallow farm animal**  
Create a farm animal using marshmallows and toothpicks and decorate it. Must be displayed on a paper plate.

**Special**

- 12. Egg carton sheep**  
Use egg carton and decorate

**Grade 3 & 4:**

- 13. Tie dye a T-shirt**  
Must only be a T-Shirt! Get creative with the colours

- 14. Draw a barn**  
On an 8½" X 11" page using pencil crayons
- 15. Farm themed bookmark**  
Create a farm themed bookmark
- 16. Create a popsicle barn**  
Using popsicle sticks to create and decorate no larger than 12" in any direction
- 17. Perler bead farm animal keychain**  
Using Perler beads create a farm animal of your choice. Must have a keychain/keyring attached.

**Special**

- 18. Egg carton pig**  
Create, decorate and paint

**Grade 5 & 6:**

- 19. Paper mâché farm animal mask**  
Using paper mâché make a mask of a farm animal of your choosing
- 20. Make a rainbow loom bracelet**
- 21. Barn building**  
Build a barn from Lego - no larger than 10"x10" in any direction including base - no kits allowed - Must be stable for moving
- 22. Farm fall wreath**  
Create a farm themed fall wreath using any recycled materials. Wreath can be no larger than 10" in diameter. Must be ready to hang
- 23. Draw a picture 'My Favourite Farm Animal'**  
No larger than 8½"X11" page

**Special**

- 24. Egg carton farm tractor**  
Transform egg cartons into a tractor. Paint & decorate.

**Grade 7 & 8:**

- 25. Lego farm tractor**  
Build a Lego tractor - no larger than 12" x 12" including base - no kits allowed - Must be stable for moving
- 26. Create a mini barn quilt**  
No larger than 12" X 12"
- 27. Create a scrapbook page depicting theme**  
(Hints: Be sure to fill the page and be sure that the page tells a story)
- 28. Create a scarecrow**  
Not larger than 18" in height by 12" wide.
- 29. Make a farm centerpiece**  
Using any material of your choice, create a centerpiece for a table no larger than the size of a dinner plate

**Special**

- 30. Egg carton creation depicting the 'Farm to Fork' theme.**  
Using ½ an egg carton, create a colourful flower garden. Use paints, colours, paper, etc.

### HOW TO ENTER TAG CLASSES

1. Pick the classes you want to enter. It is best to order a tag for every class you think you might enter. You must have a tag for each exhibit. If you do not use them all, that's okay.
2. To enter, register online at <https://www.assistexpo.ca/perthfair> or fill in the entry form at <https://www.perthfair.com/entry-forms> and submit it in person or by e-mail. Please fill in all information requested, including birthdate if under 18 years of age.
3. The office is open Monday to Friday during August and is located in the AGRICON building on the fairgrounds. Should the office be closed please leave them in the mail slot in the door.
4. When we receive your entry form it will be entered on a first in, first entered basis and your TAGS will be printed within two business days, starting after **August 1st**.
5. Tags must be picked up at the office BEFORE 4pm, Wednesday, September 2, 2026.
6. Due to space constraints all information may not be printed on tags - the prize list has the full requirements and the rules that must be followed to qualify for prizes.
7. Bring your exhibit with the tag attached to the Lindsay Campbell Horse Barn or Homecraft Building on Wednesday, September 2, 2026 between 6:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.; unless otherwise stated.
8. Judging will take place Thursday, September 3rd, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.; unless otherwise stated.
9. Please pick up your entries Monday, September 7th, 2026. Entries not picked up at this time will be composted.
10. For Junior entries, please pick up your entry items between September 7<sup>th</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup> at the Fair Office. Entries not picked up AFTER September 30<sup>th</sup> will be composted.
11. For winning entries, prize money will be mailed to you after the fair. Please indicate on the entry form if you wish the cheque to be addressed to someone other than the exhibitor (i.e. parent instead of child's name).
